SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) Storm Water Management Plan NPDES Phase II

DISCUSSION:

The City Council reviewed an update regarding a Storm Water Management Plan (SWMP) at their September 23rd regular meeting. Staff has continued to compile information regarding the requirements of the Regional Water Quality Control Board. A meeting has been scheduled with the Home Builders Association and staff is working on scheduling a meeting with the Regional Board Staff. A discussion of the requirements was included on the agenda of the Mayor's meeting held on October 3rd. San Luis Obispo County City Managers have held a meeting on the issue and are planning follow-up meetings.

Cities in the six-county region are working to understand the Regional Board's requirements and the associated costs. Attached is a matrix developed by staff highlighting the current status of region cities relative to the SWMP requirements. The matrix is developing each day as significant financial and staff resources from region cities are focused on the SWMP requirements. The positions of the cities are evolving and there are more unknowns than recognized at the previous Council review.

The City has received the remaining comments from Regional Board Staff regarding the previously submitted SWMP.
