- > Very Important! Before you sign a lease, call the Community Development Department to find out if the zoning for the property allows for your planned use or if it requires a Use Permit.

## **☑** City Business Checklist

- Finalize your Business Plan.
- Determine if you need a Fictitious Business Name. If so, post a legal notice in a local publication. Call Atascadero News at (805) 466-2585.
- Determine if you need a Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) from the Federal Government. A free service.
- Does your business have employees? Obtain a CA Employer's ID Number.
- Identify your preferred business location. Before signing your lease, confirm if your business is allowed in the property's zoning district. Contact the Community Development Department at (805) 461-5035.
- Apply for formal Zoning Approval with the City of Atascadero Community Development Department.
- Obtain a Seller's Permit, if applicable.
- Other agency approvals may apply such as:
  - County Public Health for restaurants
  - \*Alcohol Beverage Control for drinking establishments
- Do you plan on doing any Tenant Improvements or construction?

Discuss potential plans with the City. Submit a Building Permit Application. Contact the Community Development Department at (805) 461-5035.

One month prior to opening your business, apply for a City Business License.
