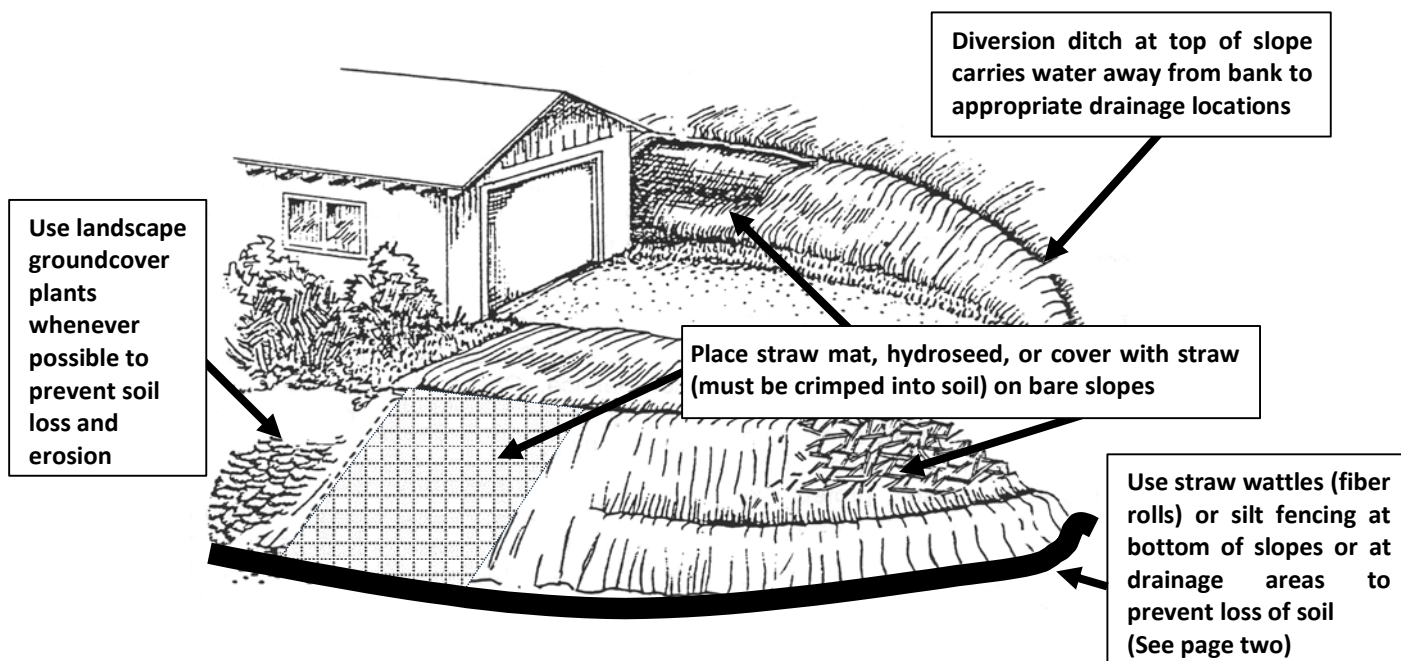

EROSION CONTROL

Erosion Control is required year-round for all construction projects which involve grading or soil disturbance. This document provides samples of some typical erosion control methods.

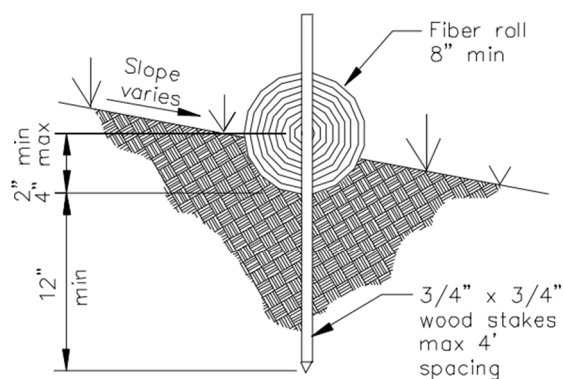
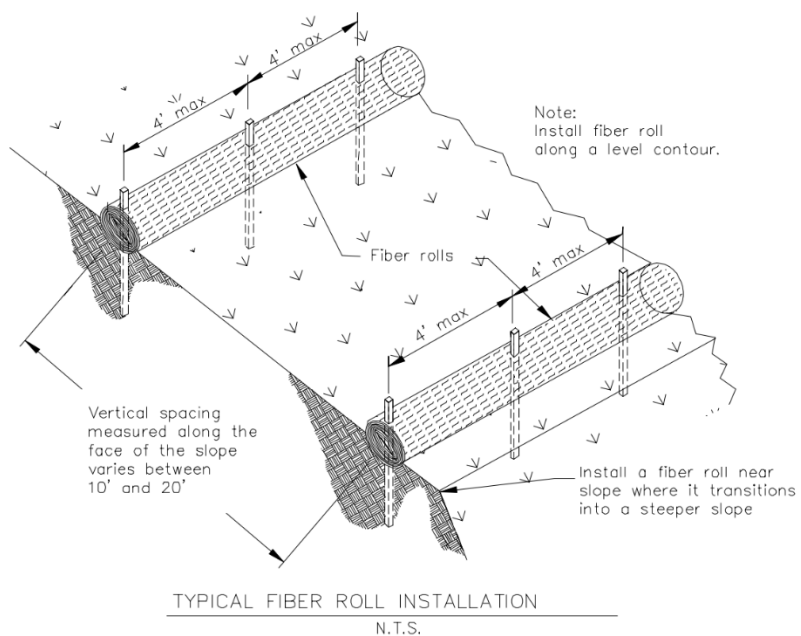
